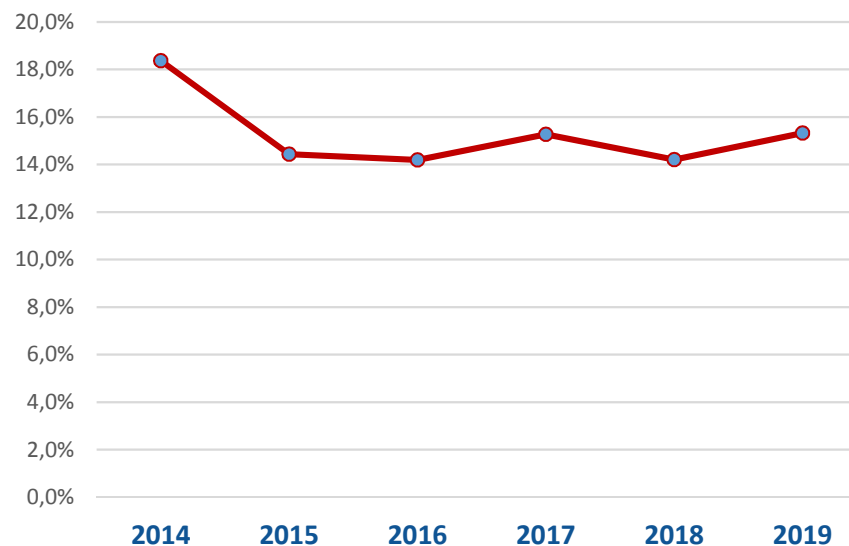

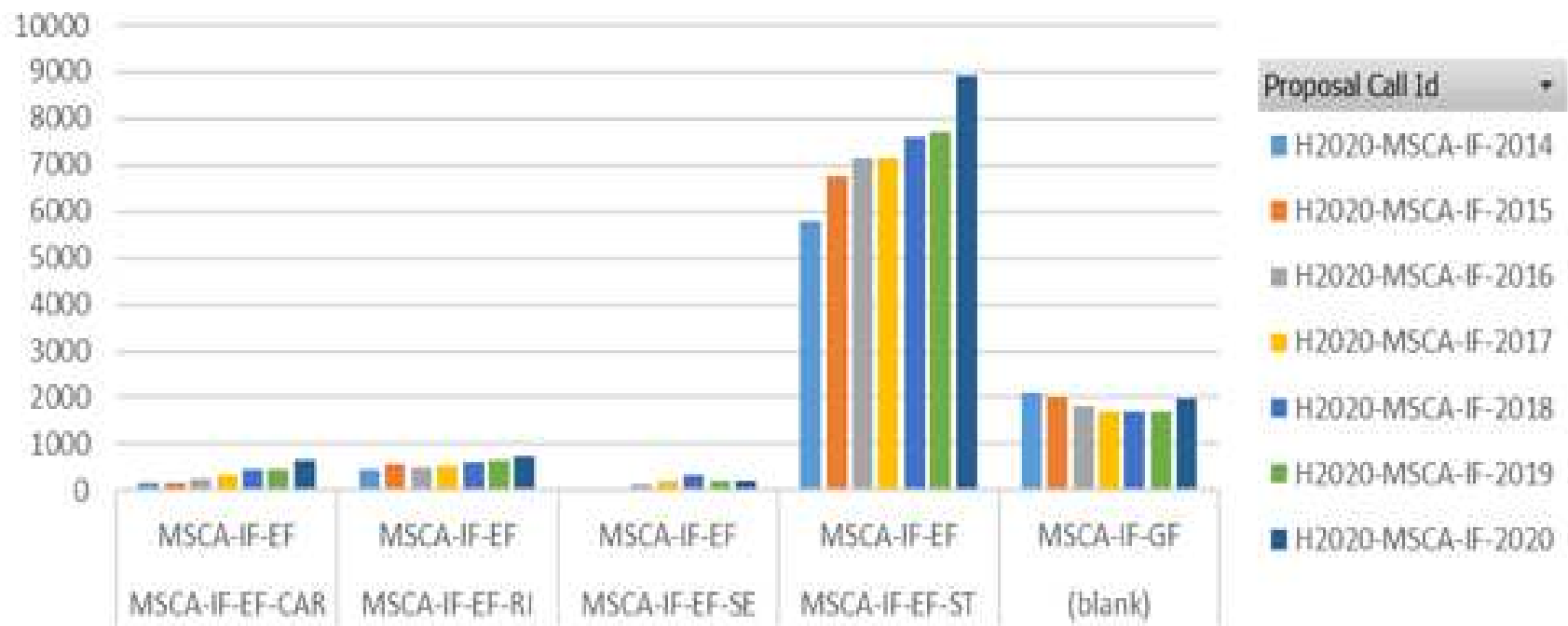

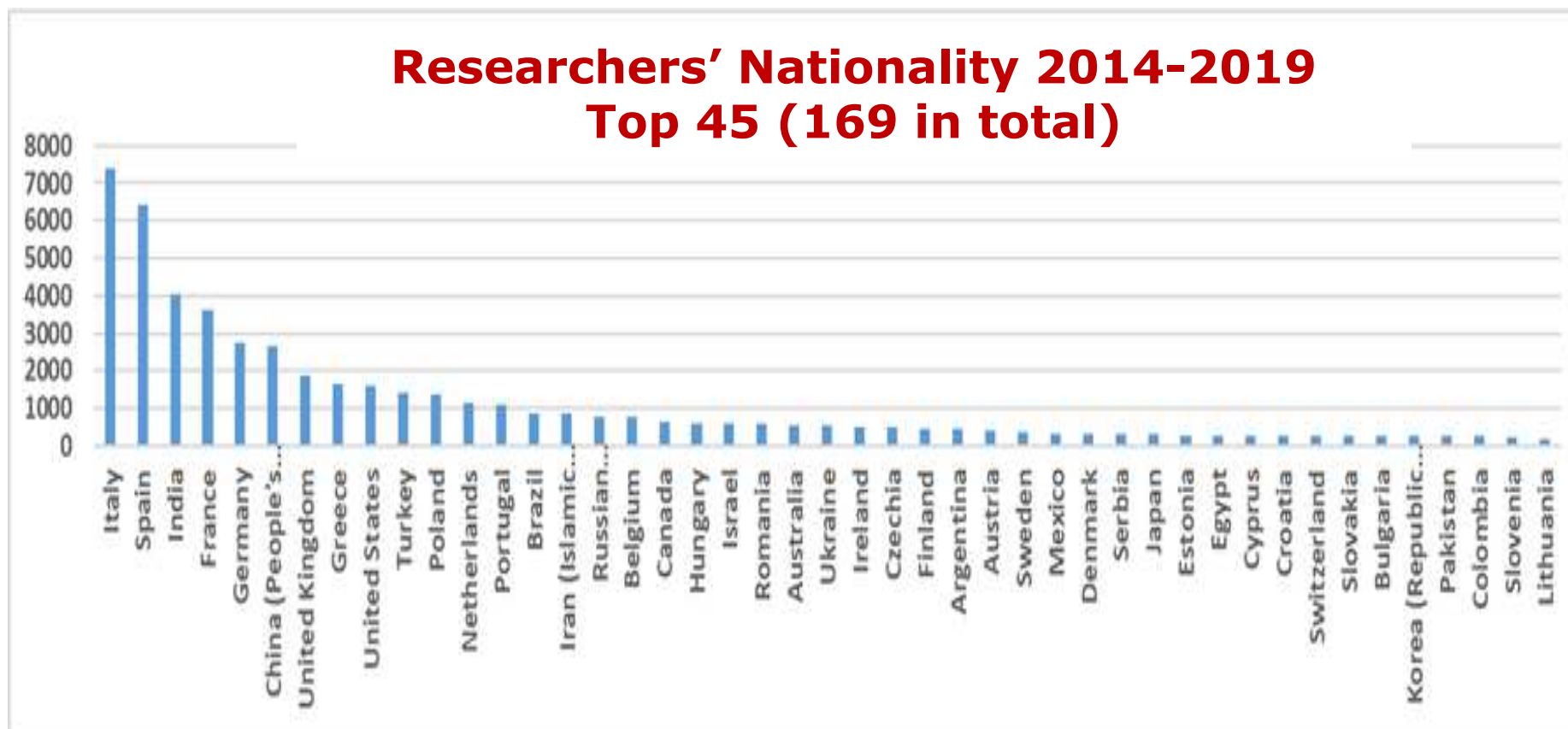

Proposal Submission per action



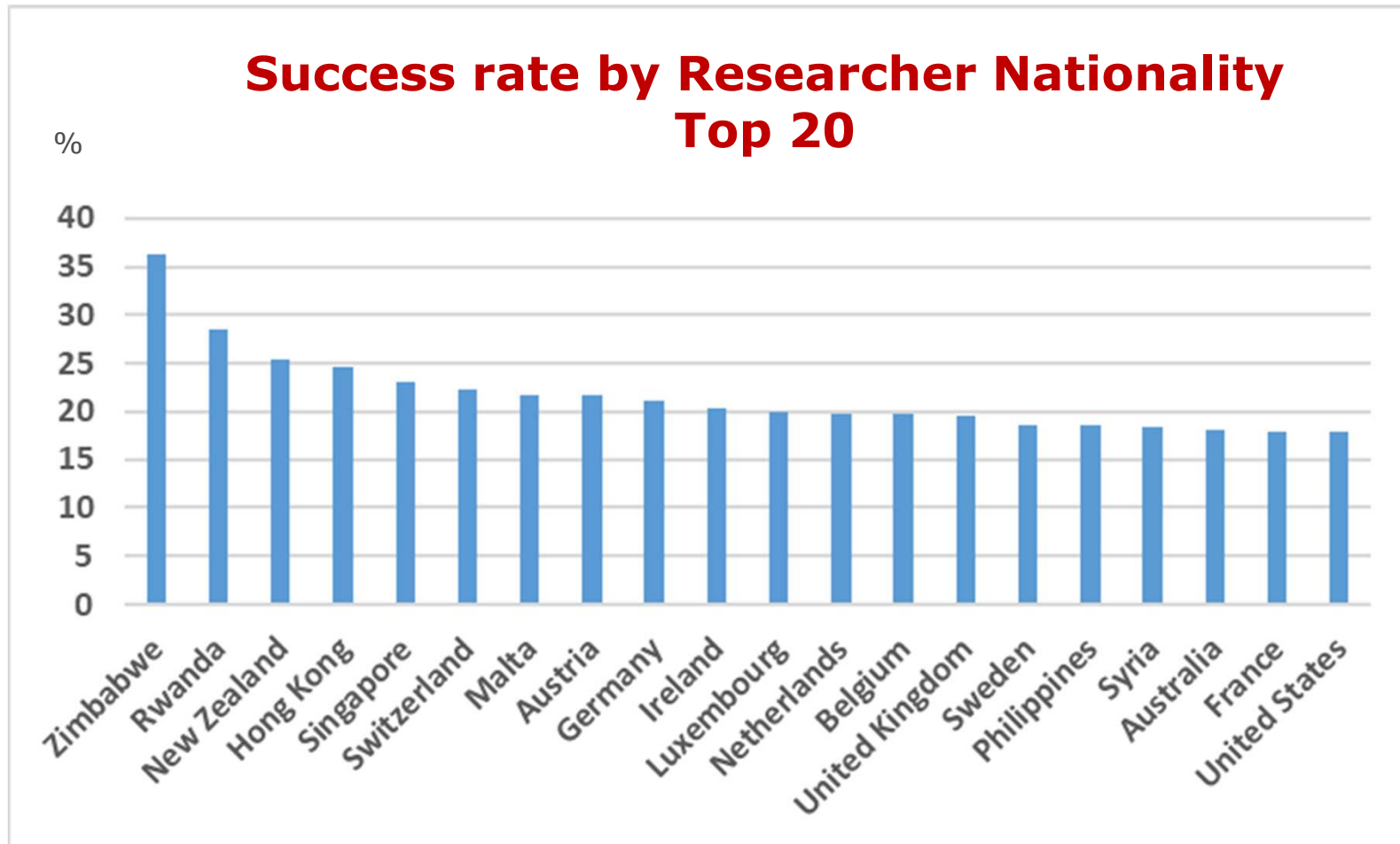

Researchers' Nationality in submitted proposals



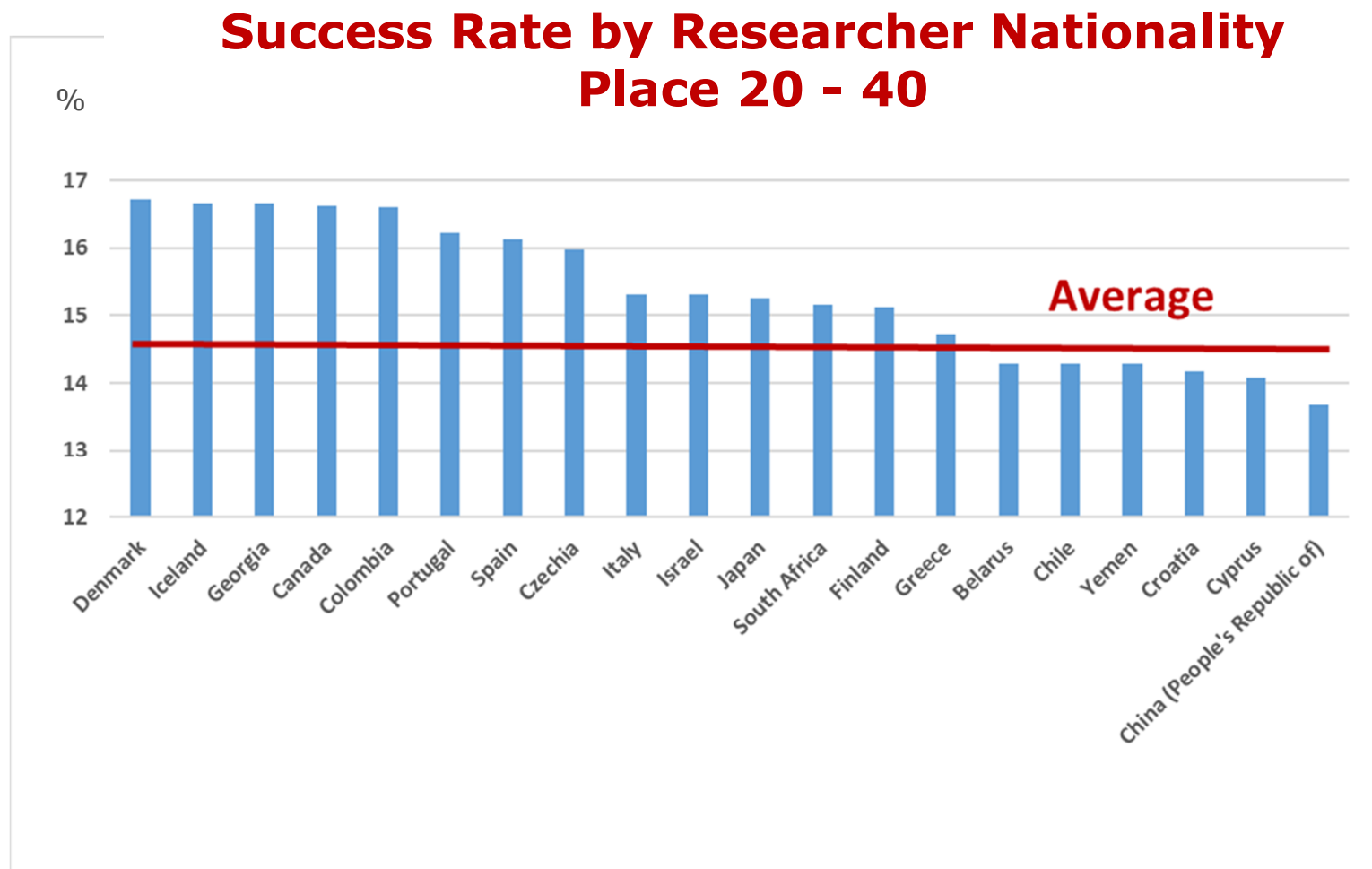

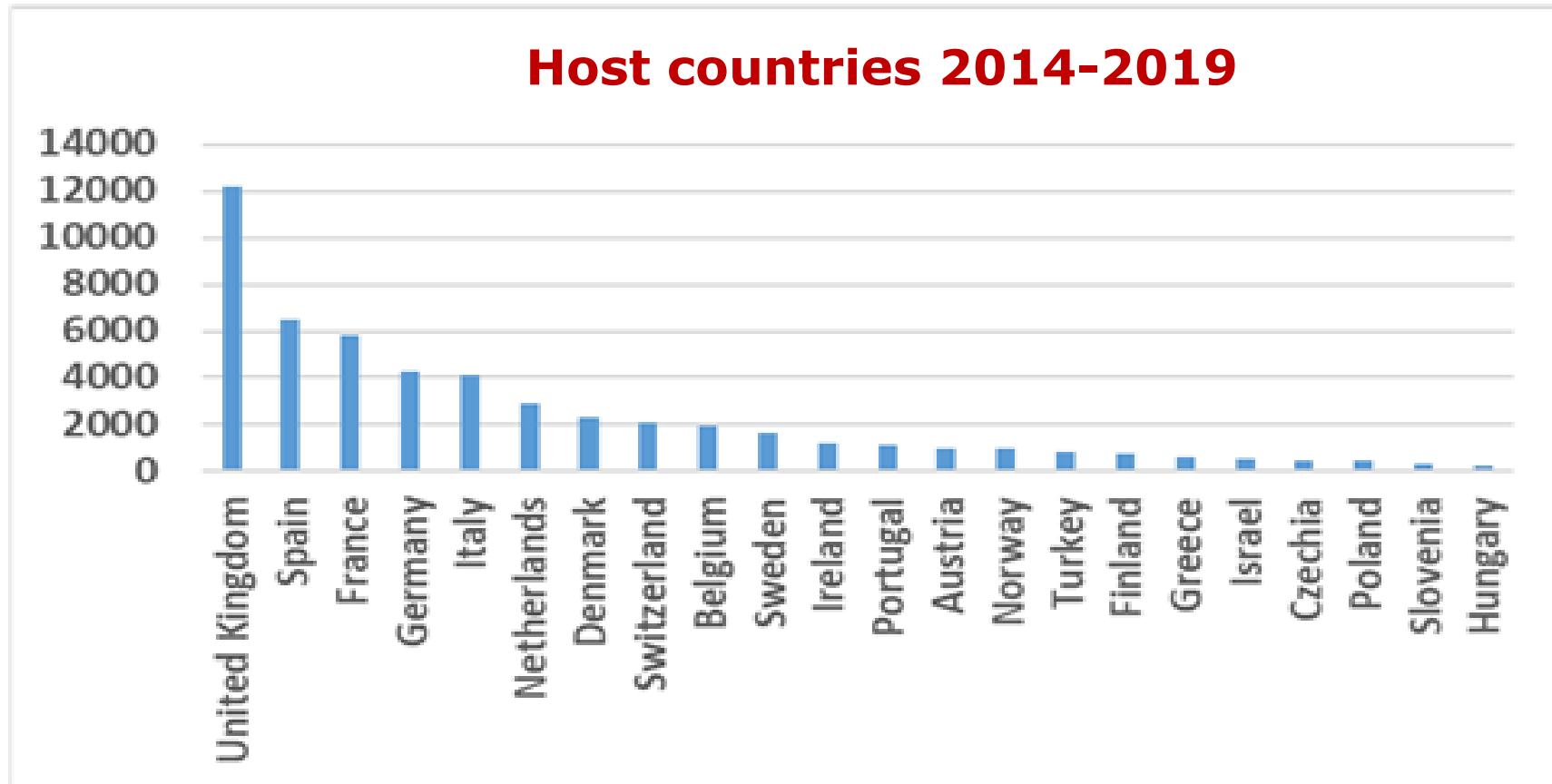

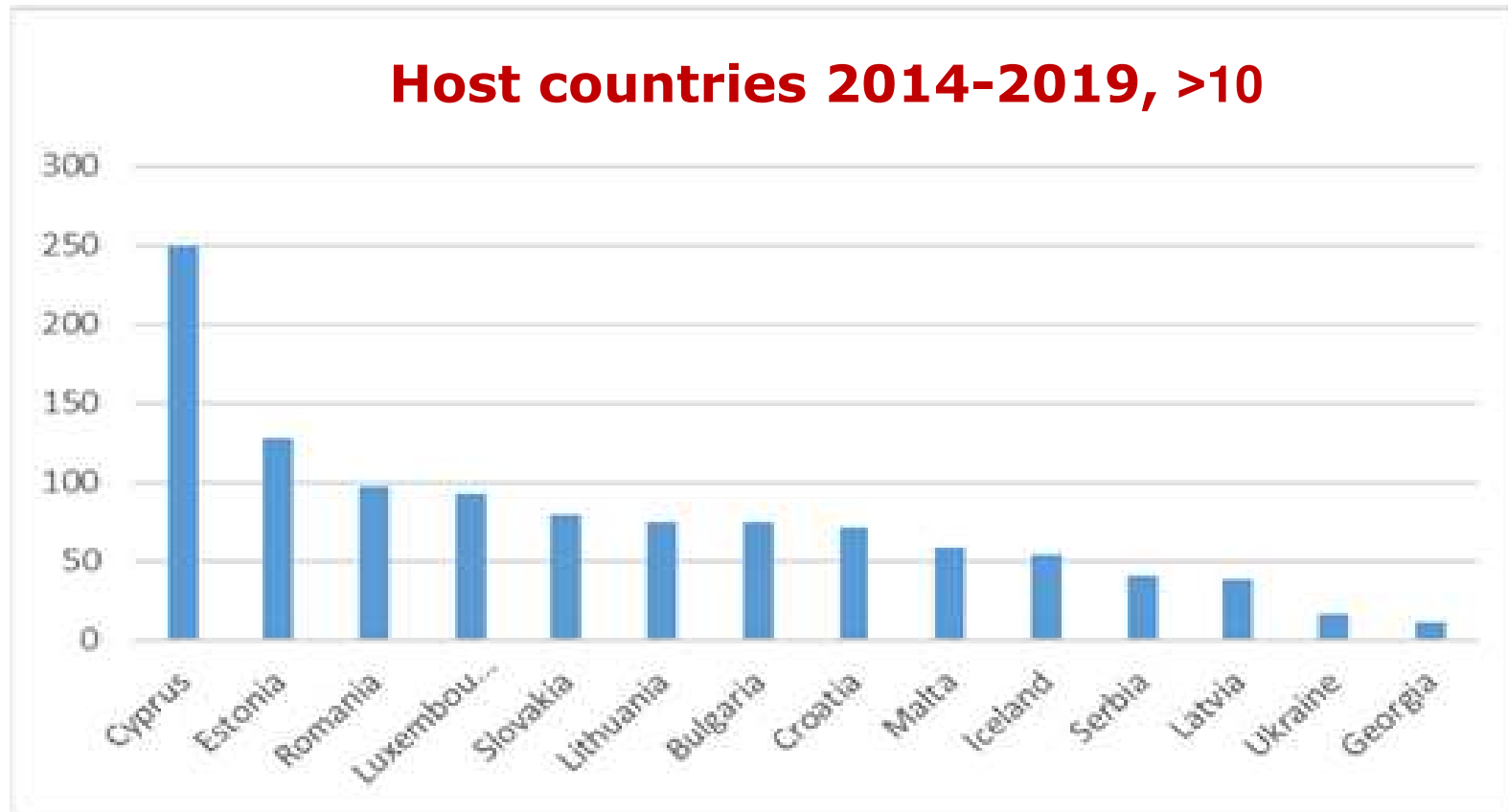

Host countries in submitted proposals (1)



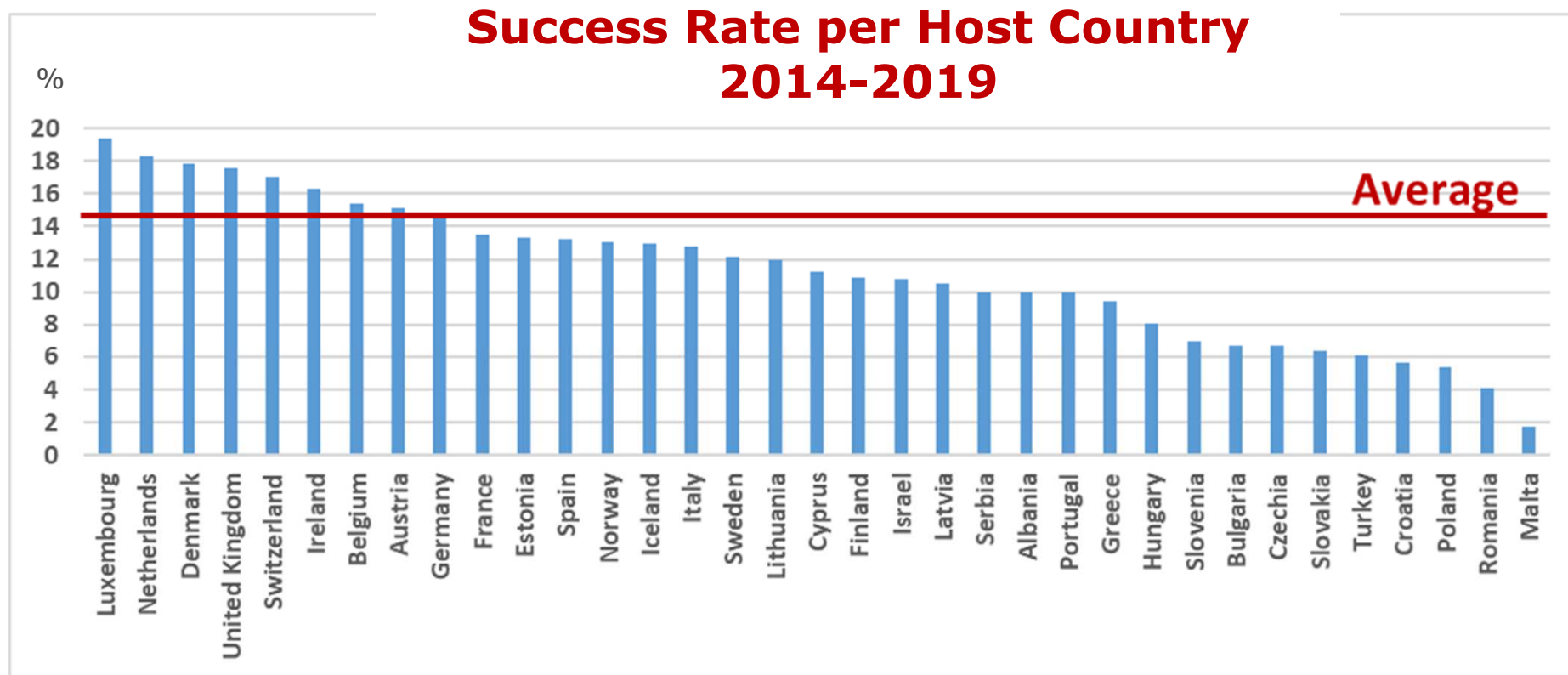

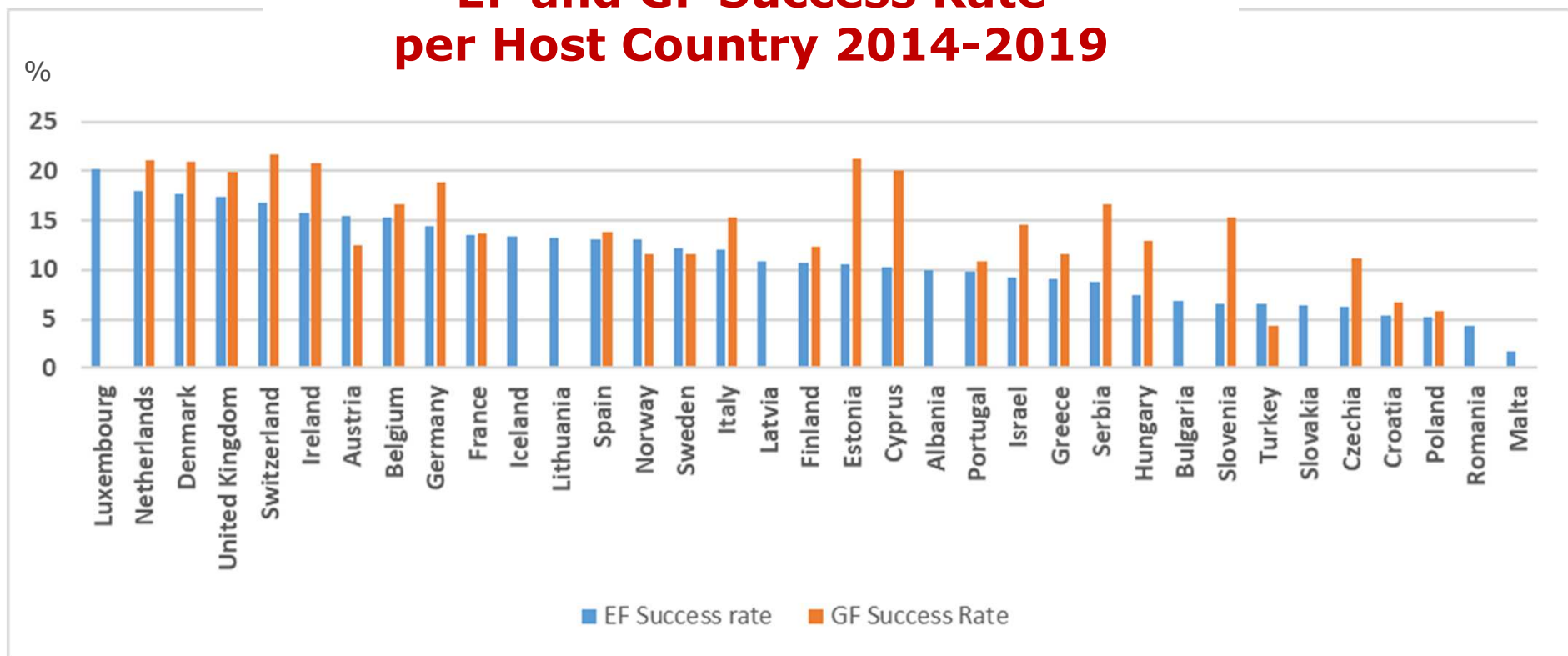
Success rate per Host Country
