- Understand the climate impact potential (mitigation potential) of their innovations following EIT Climate-KIC's Climate Impact Framework,
- Learn how to use the self-assessment tool to measure CO₂ emission reductions as well as gain insights on health, ecotoxicity, and resource depletion,
- Go through **a third-party validation** to get feedback and get support to steer the businesses towards positive impact, and
- **Build impact stories** for customers, investors and stakeholders who are relevant for their business businesses.



Our Climate Impact Framework methodology

Step 1: Workshop	Step 2: Coaching	Step 3: Validations	Step 4: Reporting
Full-day workshop, which consists of a climate impact quiz, an introduction to the science of impact assessment, examples of impactful companies and their best practices, a Cif demo and a 2 hrs guided workshop through the tool. The startups will know how to forecast their impact and have a preliminary climate impact in kgCO ₂ eq.by the end of the day.	Each startup benefits from one hour of support from an impact expert who helps to improve the calculations and advises the startup how to best communicate their impact with the Cif tool. The impact experts are experienced impact assessment specialists, ready to support the startups to do their impact forecasts, unearth relevant LCA data and find potential for improvement.	The validation is a structured check of a climate impact forecast by a third party LCA expert, who provides feedback and time for a revision before determining if the impact forecast is positive, significant, and valid.	The reporting consists of an executive summary & impact story, validated Climate impact forecast file, an impact projection and a future scenario. The report can be shared with investors or presented online as a showcase.

Selection process

- Fulfill eligibility criteria (EIC beneficiary, climate impact)
- Provided the EIC beneficiaries meet the eligibility criteria they will be selected on a first come first served basis until the maximum capacity is met
- Balanced geographical and gender distribution
- Selected start-ups will receive the confirmation asap or latest in the first week of February
