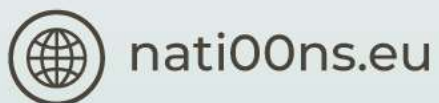

HuMUS main aim is to facilitate the deployment of the Soil Mission across regions and municipalities, through:

- the creation and experimentation of **spaces for social dialogue on soil health** among public and private actors in Europe;
- the promotion of a shared understanding and **co-assessment exercises of soil challenges** (biophysical and socio-economic dimensions);
- the enhancement of **knowledge sharing among municipalities and regions**, including on the needed transformations in current S4 (Sustainable Smart Specialization) strategies and the use of available EU funds to support the transition.

Support the **involvement of stakeholders and citizens in the decision-making processes** via case studies, educational and capacity building activities and exchanges of best practices at regional and local levels

Empower Regions and municipalities to propose appropriate and realistic solutions together with citizens and stakeholders through a **participatory approach**
