MIP4Adapt has issued a survey to evaluate the climate resilience support available to European regions or local authorities. We want to know opinions from EU regions and local authorities regarding the general support available to them to prepare and plan for climate resilience.

There is a section specifically for Charter Signatories and/or members of the EU Mission Adaptation Community of Practice, with two additional questions regarding the specific support around funding and stakeholder and citizen engagement available.

Latest news from MIP4Adapt

Technical Assistance Update

Exclusively for EU Mission Charter Signatories, MIP4Adapt's Technical Assistance provides a programme of support carefully designed to address the distinctive needs of each region. Some of the latest highlights include:

- 96 applications total
- Next cut-off date: 30 June 2024
- 46 regions with support started
- Approximately 20 regions in the preliminary phase, with starting dates planned for the next two-three months.

As task lead for the MIP4Adapt Technical Assistance, I'm impressed by the diversity of needs, challenges and capacities reflected in the applications, emphasising the importance of tailoring our service to support the unique requirements of each region effectively. It's reassuring to see these efforts are valued by the regions who are working with us through the feedback received praising our flexibility as well as the professionality and understanding of regional contexts of our Member State Facilitators.
